Special Note: "7th **MEXICAN OPEN COMPETITION**" will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Figure Skating as well as pertinent ISU Communications. Participation in the Narcisa Cup 2023 is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 b) and c) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication from 2030 to 2526 or any update of it.

Participation on the Open Format Events: Each ISU Member/Club may enter competitors in any skating event. Entries may be admitted by Clubs, not only Skating Unions, Federations or Associations.



Responsibilities: In accordance with the ISU Regulations, Rule 119, all participants act on their own responsibility. The organizer will provide basic medical emergency aid during competition and practice.

Citizen / Residence requirements and Clearance Procedure: In accordance with Rule 109 of ISU Regulations and ISU Communication from 2030 to 2526 or any update of it, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. The local organizing committee has the right and obligation to check the personal identification documents of the athletes to determine whether they are allowed to compete, whether they are competing in the right category, etc. Without the documents, the athlete will be excluded from the competition.

Music: Music will be reproduced from <u>ONLY mp3 format</u> on USB Stick it must be labeled clearly with the competitor's name, Club/National Federation and category in which the competitor is competing. Such labeled USB should be delivered to the organizer immediately after the arrival upon the first practice.

Judging System: For all Events the ISU Judging System will be used.

Expenses: The full board hotel accommodation for the invited Officials: Referees, Judges, Technical Controllers and Specialists will be arranged and born by the organizer from the dinner on the day before starting the events, until breakfast after the completion of the event. **The cover of all expenses for competitors, team leaders, coaches, etc.**; **is the sole responsibility of the teams participating.**

Charges: Entry fee \$150 USD per competitor with - Free skate & Short Program (Adult Free skate & Artistic Program) MEXICAN PARTICIPANTS \$3,000.- MXP

Entry fee \$120 USD per competitor with - Free skate Only Events. MEXICAN PARTICIPANTS \$2,400.- MXP. LATE FEE +50 USD

Close of Entries – Friday APRIL 16, 2023 at 24 hrs. Mexico City Time, Fees for MEXICAN Participants must be collected by Associations by this date. INTERNATIONAL Participants only must send their competition information and flight number as confirmation of participation at the event.

The participants are kindly asked to inform the Organizer about intention of participation with e-mail note to these 3 e-mail addresses simultaneously by date of close of entries.

Two repetitions maximum per element are permitted within the 5 element limit, after these any repeated element or extra has a 2 point deduction from total.
