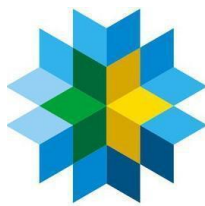
Dear athletes, coaches, referees and officials,

The Brazilian Ice Sports Federation is pleased to announce the venue, dates and information about the **“Campeonato Brasileiro de Patinação Artística no Gelo 2022”** and the **“1º Open America Latina”**. The two events will occur simultaneously, being that the Brazilian Figure Skating Championships will be only for high performance technical levels and the Open Figure Skating Championships, besides these, will contemplate the other technical levels and will be open to Latin American countries, members of the ISU.

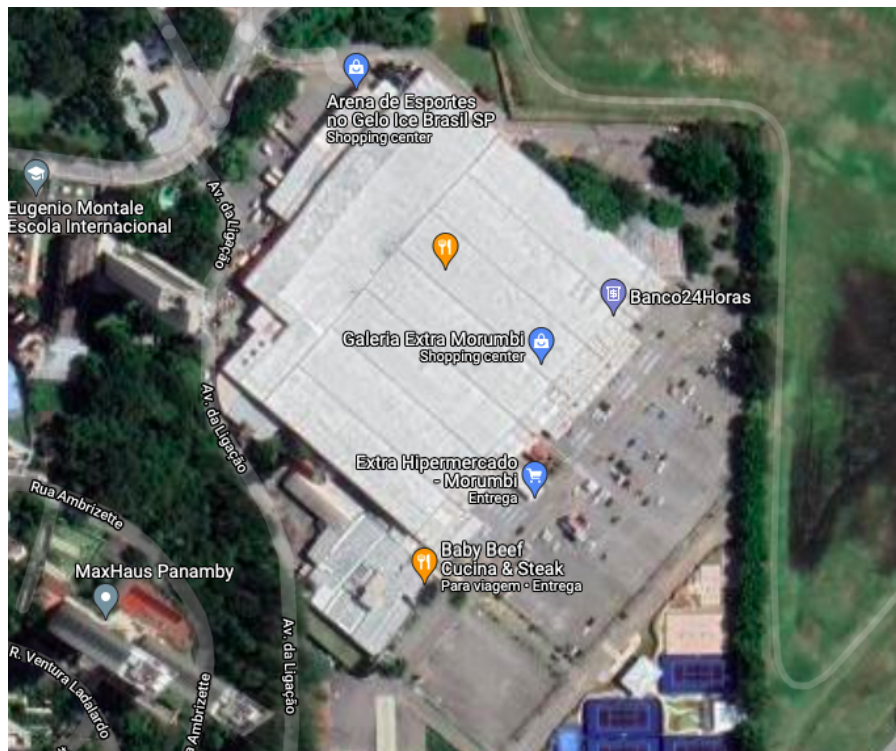
**Venue**

Arena Ice Brazil: Avenida Major Sylvio de Magalhães Padilha, 16741, Morumbi, São Paulo - SP.

The access to the Arena Ice Brazil is through the side street of the Extra Hypermarket located on Marginal Pinheiros. As shown in the picture below:

The competition venue has a 486m<sup>2</sup> track, with dimensions of 18x27m.

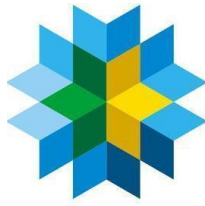
For athletes who **do not live in São Paulo**:

In the week preceding the “1° Open America Latina”, ice will be made available to these athletes, for familiarization of the size of the rink where the competition will take place. The schedule available will be from 07:00 a.m. to 09:00 a.m., between July 11 and 15, 2022, at a cost of BRL30.00 per hour of ice per athlete.

This training will be exclusive for athletes who do not live or train in São Paulo. Athletes who train at Arena Ice Brazil will not be able to participate in this schedule.

### Categories

Age levels apply for each technical level below, according to CBDG (Brazilian Ice Sports Federation) technical regulations (<http://www.cbdg.org.br/ice-brasil/regulamentos/>).



**CBDG**

For the “**Campeonato Brasileiro de Patinação Artística no Gelo 2022**” the categories are:

- Novice Advanced;
- Junior;
- Sênior.

For the “**1º Open America Latina**”, the Technical Levels are:

- Pré-iniciante;
- Iniciante;
- Pré-Básico;
- Juvenil;
- Intermediário (Short Program e Free Skate);
- Adulto Brasil I;
- Adulto Brasil II;
- Adulto Bronze;
- Adulto Prata;
- Adulto Ouro;
- Artístico.
- Novice Advanced;
- Junior;
- Sênior.

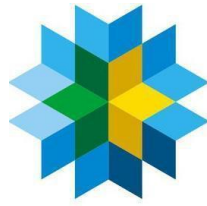
*Note: Both competitions will be judged using the ISU judging system.*

## **Entry**

Entries will take place between **April 15th and May 31st**.

Entry fee for the technical level BRL 150.00.



**CBDG**

For participation in the artistic level the fee will be BRL 100.00.

Remarks:

- For group competitions of the artistic level each participant pays the fee of BRL 100.00.
- Brazilian athletes registered in the Novice Advanced, Júnior and Sênior Open categories will automatically be entered in the Brazilian Championship.
- For the artistic level, a separate registration will be made if the competitor participates, but on the same form. The fee will be BRL 100.00, and there will also be a section on the form itself to attach proof of registration.

In other words, the athlete can:

1. Participate only in the Open and Championship (if it is Brazilian and participates in one of the categories: Novice Advanced, Junior and Senior, he/she will automatically participate in both) with a fee of BRL 150.00;

2. Participate in the Open and Championship (if it is Brazilian and participates in one of the categories: Novice Advanced, Junior and Senior, he will automatically participate in both) and participate in the artistic level with a fee of BRL 250.00.

3. Or, participate only in the artistic level for a fee of BRL 100.00

- Athletes who register only for the artistic championship but in two categories: singles and group will only pay one registration fee.
- Remember that for the 2022 competitions in the categories Novice Advanced, Junior, Senior (Brazilian Championship) and Intermediário (Open - by the Brazilians - ) a LEVEL TEST will be required. The participants must send videos performing the mandatory elements of their level between May 1st and May 15th, 2022 to [teste.patinacao@cbdorg.org.br](mailto:teste.patinacao@cbdorg.org.br).

Observations: For the other nationalities it will not be mandatory to take the level test, however, it will be necessary to send a statement from the Country Federation of origin



of the athlete, at the time of registration (form), stating that he/she has the mandatory elements.

If it is noticed, during the execution of the Short Program, by the Technical and Judges Pannel, that the competitor does not have all the mandatory elements of the level entered, he/she will be disqualified.

#### **Docket or summary**

The Scoresheet Template was sent with the registration email. If you have not received it, please request it by emailing [esportes@cbdorg.org.br](mailto:esportes@cbdorg.org.br). They must be delivered at the registration, along with the USB flash drives with MP3 songs (take a copy for security).

#### **Awards**

There will be awards for the first three winners in all categories and technical levels.

There will be a gala presentation for the best skaters in both competitions.
