1. Invitation

Candidates of the following ISU Members are invited to apply for the 2nd Peruvian Educational Series: Officials Training – 2023

- Federación Argentina de Patinaje sobre Hielo
- Confederação Brasileira de Desportos no Gelo
- Federación Nacional Chilena de Patinaje Artístico Sobre Hielo
- Federación Ecuatoriana de Patinaje
- Federación Peruana de Patinaje sobre Hielo

2. Requirements

The course is open to candidates approved for your respective ISU Federations. All candidates must understand English and be able to speak it with some fluently. This training course is mainly designed to people with no previous knowledge of figure skating, however candidates with figure skating knowledge can participate both with the previous approval of their respective ISU Federations. There are 20 places available for this first course, so they will be assigned up to 4 Candidates from each country. If there are fewer Candidates per country, the remaining places will be assigned on a “first come, first serve” basis.

3. Course Structure

This course was designed with help of USFS judges Mrs. Charlotte Heindenreich and Mrs. Molly Marron with the supervision of Mrs. Gale Tanger (ISU Referee and Technical Controller, ISU Gold Award of Merit winner and member of the US Figure Skating Hall of fame)

The course consists of **25 virtual sessions** that will be launched weekly [on the ISU eLearning platform](#) with videos, readings, and online assignments for students to do on their own and will finish with a Virtual trial judging at the Latin American Interclub Competition and a Live Trial Judging at the Mexican National both in November (Flight Tickets and Hotel Expenses for the 3 candidates who has obtained the best grades will be covered)

*Important: The absences percentage to the sessions should not exceed 20%

- Interactive Sessions will take place each **Wednesday at 7:00 pm (PET ,GMT -5) May 31st until November 1st, 2023.**
- Virtual Trial Judging, November 3th to 5th.
- Live Trial Judging, November 27th to 30th.

4. Entries

All entries must be submitted before April 30th, 2023.
